WHEREAS, Christian DelPrince has a contract of sale with the current landowner, Mr. Frank Gugino, contingent upon his ability to rezone the property, and

WHEREAS, any future development of this parcel to be rezoned is subject to a full site plan application submittal, review and approval by the Planning Board and any landscaping, drainage, parking, lighting, setbacks, building heights and any other design elements shall follow the requirements of Evans Town Code, and

WHEREAS, the applicant must apply for a Special Use Permit prior to utilizing the parcel as a Motor Vehicle Sales business and should one be approved the applicant must follow any and all conditions set forth on said Special Use Permit, and

WHEREAS, the Evans Planning Director has requested that the Town Board set a public hearing regarding the request of Christian D. DelPrince

RESOLUTION 2021 #101 Execute Sale and Easement Agreements for Town Water System Project

Supervisor Hosler moved and Councilman Schraft seconded,

WHEREAS, the Town of Evans is undertaking a major Water System Improvements Project to address the current lack of adequate water capacity to meet peak demands, to provide sufficient fire protection, and to promote economic and community development in the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Water System Improvements Project involves the engineering and construction of a 1.5-million-gallon water storage tower; and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned water tower project involves the acquisition of a certain parcel from the Buffalo and Erie County Industrial Land Development Corporation, specifically located at 1526 Eden Evans Center Road, in Evans, and estimated at 1.85 acres; and

WHEREAS, Buffalo and Erie County Industrial Land Development Corporation further offers the Town access to the subject parcel via intended easements for the Town’s use and benefit, including a certain shared access drive to the proposed parcel; and

WHEREAS, the project in question shall mutually benefit both the Town and Buffalo and Erie County Industrial Land Development Corporation, including providing access to water for the benefit of both Town residents and customers of the Agri-Business Park Project; and

WHEREAS, in consideration of the combined access of water for the Agri-Business Park Project, Buffalo and Erie County Industrial Land Development Corporation imposes a purchase price of one dollar (\$1.00) for the subject water tower parcel, but shall include certain closing costs and any taxes due and owing; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Evans has considered the value of the aforementioned parcel for the Town’s Water System Project and finds it desirable to acquire the same, including but not limited to the consideration of the economic and general welfare of the public.

WHEREAS, the Town has sufficient funds available for any anticipated closing costs and expenses related to the acquisition of the subject parcel, due in part to significant grant funds made available specifically to the project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Town Board does hereby approve and authorize the Supervisor to execute all documents and enter into any agreements necessary to the acquisition of the Evans Water System Project land parcel, and related easements for access to the subject parcel; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution is conditioned upon receiving approvals from the Attorney for the Town before the execution of any contracts and/or agreements referenced herein.
