The Town of Evans appreciates input from the General Public during the Privilege of the Floor period which is offered at each Regular Meeting of the Town Board, the following policy will be enforced at every meeting:

- Speakers must be recognized by the presiding officer;
- Speakers must state their name, address and organization, if any;
- The public shall only be allowed to speak during the designated period of the meeting;
- Comments shall be related to Town of Evans business only;
- Speakers will be limited to three (3) minutes per person per period which may be timed; time in excess of 3 minutes will be at the discretion of the Town Board.
- Speakers may not yield any remaining time they may have to another speaker;
- All remarks must be addressed to the Town Board as a body and not to any individual member thereof;
- Speakers shall observe the commonly accepted rules of courtesy, decorum, dignity and good taste;

- Unacceptable behavior will not be tolerated and may result in removal from the building and/or loss of future privileges of the floor.

In addition, interested parties or their representatives may address the Town Board by written communication. Any documents submitted to the Town Board will be accepted and filed for one (1) year.

- C. The agenda shall not be departed from except with a simple majority vote of the entire Town Board.
- D. If the Town Board has voted to depart from the agenda, as provided above, the Town Board may, by a simple majority vote of the entire Town Board, require that any resolutions not on the agenda be produced in written form prior to a vote being taken on such resolution.
- E. All matters shall be continued on the agenda until disposed of. All matters not disposed of shall be tabled and taken from the table only by a simple majority vote of the entire Town Board.
- F. Correspondence shall be filed with the Town Clerk and

retained for one (1) year, pursuant to the retention schedule.

- G. Whenever the Town Board amends a resolution passed at a previous meeting, there shall be added to the official record of minutes of such previous meeting a marginal notation referring to the subsequent amending action.

RESOLVED: Investment Policy -- The objectives of the Investment Policy of the Town of Evans are to minimize risk; to ensure that investments mature when the cash is required to finance operations; and to insure a competitive rate of return.

In accordance with the policy, the Chief Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to invest all funds, including proceeds of obligations and reserve funds in:

Certificates of Deposit/Time Deposits Accounts with Evans Bank, Manufacturers and Traders Trust Company, Chase/JP Morgan Bank, NYCLASS and/or TD Ameritrade.; and

Repurchase Agreements involving the purchase and sale of direct obligations of the United States; and

All other Town Officials receiving money in their official capacity must deposit such funds in negotiable order of withdrawal accounts with Evans Bank, Manufacturers and Traders Trust Company, Chase/JP Morgan Bank, NYCLASS and/or TD Ameritrade.

COLLATERAL - All Town deposits shall be fully secured by insurance of the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation or by obligations of New York State or obligations of the United States or obligations of federal agencies the principal and interest of which are guaranteed by the United States or obligations of New York State local governments.

Collateral shall be held by the seller bank's trust department or its designate. The market value of collateral shall at all times equal or exceed the principal amount of the certificate of deposit. Collateral shall be monitored no less frequently than quarterly.

Investments in time deposits/certificates of deposit and repurchase agreements are to be made with banks or trust companies.

The Town will encourage the purchase and sale of investments through a competitive or negotiated process involving telephone solicitation of at least two bids for each transaction.

At the time independent auditors conduct the annual audit of the accounts and financial affairs of the Town, the independent auditors shall audit the investments of the Town for compliance with the provisions of these Investment Guidelines.

The provisions of these Investment Guidelines any amendments hereto shall take effect prospectively, and shall not invalidate prior investment.
