Project Description:

The Department has received an application for the rehabilitation of the Sturgeon Point Marina breakwater which has significant damage from past storms. The proposed work consists of sloped heavy armor stone on the lakeward side and marina side to be installed at a shallower angle. The sidewalk, posts, and concrete barrier along the inside of the marina will also be replaced. A temporary access road in the water is proposed to allow access for construction equipment. The project is located at Sturgeon Point Marina at 618 Sturgeon Point Rd in the Town of Evans. The Department is seeking comments on the proposed regulated activity prior to making a final decision on permit issuance.
