WHEREAS, Chief of Police Masullo contacted Erie County Department of Public Works to request a reduction in speed limits on certain highways in the Town of Evans; and WHEREAS, Erie County Department of Public Works responded by sending permit applications for each request; therefore be it

RESOLVED, that Supervisor Pordum is hereby authorized to enter into agreements with the Erie County Department of Public Works regarding the following permits:

-request permission for furnish, install and maintain a "45 MPH Linear Speed Limit" on Eden-Evans Center Road (CR 32) between Delamater Road (CR 477) and Route 20;

-request permission to furnish, install and maintain a "40 MPH Linear Speed Limit" on Eden-Evans Center Road (CR 32) between North Main Street (CR 9) and Delamater Road (CR 477);

-request permission to furnish, install and maintain a "45 MPH Linear Speed Limit" on Eden- Evans Center Road (CR 32) between Route 20 and Townline Road;

-request permission to furnish, install and maintain a "35 MPH Linear Speed Limit" on Lake Street (CR 5) between Erie Road (SR 5) and Lakeshore Road (CR 111);

-request permission to furnish, install and maintain a "45 MPH Linear Speed Limit" on Versailles Plank Road (CR 41) between Sturgeon Point Road (CR 18) and Overhead Road; and further be it

RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk is hereby directed to provide 5 certified copies of this resolution to the Evans Police Department to be forwarded to Erie County with each sign permit application executed by the Town of Evans.
