BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of Evans respectfully objects to the proposed placement of a facility operated by Community Services for the Developmentally Disabled tentatively scheduled to be built on Pontiac Road in the Town of Evans; and

WHEREAS, it is the Town Board’s firm belief that there are sufficient similar facilities within our municipality to service any relevant need and that the addition of another would place a further burden on the taxpayers of our Town to provide basic services to such facility, alter the character of the neighborhood and further cause a relative concentration and saturation of such facilities in the Town of Evans; and

WHEREAS, it is recognized that a need for the establishment of similar facilities has in the past existed and that such facilities serve a proper and just purpose fulfilled in the Town of Evans by existing and established residences the construction and placement of such the additional proposed facility would alter the existing agricultural nature of the neighborhood, create a sense of unease to the existing residents, negatively impact the tax structure and the existing infrastructure of the Town.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,

That the Town of Evans and its citizens officially oppose the establishment of this facility or any other similar such facility within our municipality for the above mentioned reasons.
